Supplement: Installing GlassFish 3 on NetBeans 7

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GlassFish is not installed in NetBeans 7 by default. Here are the steps to install it:

Step 1: Under the Services window, right-click the Servers tab to choose **Add Server**, as shown in Figure 1.1a.

Step 2: In the Add Server Instance dialog (Figure 45ab), select **GlassFish Server 3.x** and click *Next* to download the server.

Step 3: After the server is downloaded, you will be prompted to register local domain, as shown in Figure 1.3. Use the default domain **domain1** and check **Use default port**. Click *Finish* to complete installation.
